Religion:

Math:

Objectives

Can students multiply using two digit by three digit numbers?
Can students round numbers to the nearest place value? (to the millions)
Can students estimate sums and differences for large numbers?
Can students write large numbers (to the millions) in expanded form?
Can students write large numbers (to the millions) in word format?

Science:
