Brief description of PTA Committees/Event Opportunities for this coming school year

PTA FUNDRAISERS- these events/programs are essential money makers that fund our PTA initiatives

FALL FLOWER SALE: Sign-up to sort bulbs, organize school family orders, work shifts day of set-up and day of pick-up!

ANNUAL AUCTION: Sign-up to work on committees throughout the year or just day/night of the auction! Help with logistics, acquisitions, publicity, decorations, set-up, clean-up and check-out.

SCRIP: This is program generates year round revenue for PTA as well as our Parish Social Services. Sign-up to organize, promote, and/or work shifts manning the SCRIPS table at Masses or special event.

SPECIAL EVENTS-these events raise money for specific school programs

BOOK FAIR: Take part in the school fundraiser for our library. Sign up to help set-up, check-out, and clean-up. There are fall and spring fairs. Sponsored by SCHOLASTIC BOOKS.

FATHER/DAUGHTER SNOWFLAKE DANCE: This 2nd annual event is back by popular demand. It is a night of dancing and refreshments for daughters to bring their fathers. Sign up to help with decorations, treats, set-up, and clean-up. The proceeds benefit inclusive education and our RESOURCE ROOM.

CHRISTMAS GIFT WRAPPING: Sign up for shifts to wrap gifts on scheduled days prior to Christmas. Donations received support the Christmas teachers' gift fund for our faculty/staff.

ADMINISTRATIVE-These activities directly assist our school faculty/administration during the school day.

SAFETY PATROL: Assist for morning/afternoon shifts directing traffic on Meyer and Circle Drive (drinking coffee totally acceptable)

TEACHER, LIBRARY, ART ROOM AIDES: Offer help in classroom and art room to prepare projects, make copies, supervise playground, etc. Library aides work with students and the librarian.

LUNCHROOM AIDES: Volunteers needed each school day from 11 am-1pm to assist the younger children and support the lunchroom monitor.

ROOM PARENTS: Parents are needed in each grade level to coordinate with teachers- holiday parties and other activities. Additional volunteers to provide refreshments or assist with the games, etc.

HOSPITALITY: Coordinates organization and food preparation for teacher luncheons, teacher meals during conferences, and various PTA events.

BAKING LIST: If you like to bake, this is the opportunity for you! Volunteers provide the treats and bake birthday cakes for our teachers, Book Fair, VIP/Grandparents Day, etc.

FAMILY SUPPORT MINISTRY: Committee provides meals for families that have experienced a birth or death in immediate family or families facing difficult circumstances.

SHROVE TUESDAY LUNCHEAS: Help contribute and/or serve special pre-Lenten lunch for the students and faculty.

TRIVIA NIGHT: A fun fall activity for grown-ups! Committee plans logistics, creates trivia questions, determines judging panel, set-up, and clean-up.

LOUNGE LIZARDS: This committee shows our great faculty how much we appreciate all they do by surprising them with fabulous lunches, awesome gifts, and incentives during the year.

SCHOOL FIELD DAYS: Half day celebration at close of school year. Organized by grades ECLC, K-1, 2-4, 5-6, and 7th (8th grade has various graduation activities). Held in various locations, parent chaperones are needed to assist with lunches, games, sports, and activity areas.

RECEPTIONS: Various receptions are held to celebrate sacramental milestones in our children's lives. First Communion Reception is hosted by 3rd grade parents for 2nd graders. Marian Mass is hosted by 7th grade parents for 8th graders. The Kindergarten Reception is hosted by 1st grade parents.

ART SMART: Volunteers work directly with the students by displaying and explaining prints of great works of art.

WALKING SCHOOL BUS: This organization encourages healthy habits by providing chaperoned walks for students to and from school. The different "bus groups" meet at various points throughout the parish. Parents are needed to walk along and monitor.

VIP/GRANDPARENTS' DAY: This special day in the spring is for grades K-5 to bring their special guest for a classroom visit and musical presentation. Volunteers needed to help direct guests to various areas.

SPIRIT SHOP: Fun SPS clothing and related spirit items will be available for purchase on scheduled days throughout the year. Parents needed to help sell items.

ST. PATRICK'S DAY BROOKSIDE PARADE: Helps coordinator organize the St. Peter's School entry to celebrate this community event.
